•ANCORA
COFFEE
ROASTERS

In Madison, Wisconsin, with a shop near the Capitol and three other locations, the baristas artisan-roast beans bought from "fair trade" vendors. The menu features 25 blends and lots of specialties (608/255-2900).

•BROADWAY CAFE

Beverage choices are detailed in colorful chalk on blackboards at this neighborhood coffeehouse in the trendy Westport area of Kansas City, Missouri. Customers can taste samples of that day's baked goods, including currant scones, almond soft biscotti and apple cake (816/531-2432).

•CAPERS CAFE & BAKERY

This funky eatery in Salina, Kansas, is known for delectable baked goods. There are

cinnamon rolls, scones and "ooey gooey" rolls, plus breads and bagels (785/823-7177).

•DE'LICE EUROPEAN BAKERY & CAFE

At this cafe/bakery in Omaha's historic downtown Old Market area, baker Heidi Schlicht preps and bakes a different mix of breads, pastries and desserts with a European flair that coffee and tea drinkers savor (402/342-2276).

•JERABEK'S NEW BOHEMIAN

Is it possible to have too many bakery choices? That's the delicious dilemma at the Saint Paul business started as a bakery 100 years ago. Mismatched vintage tables and chairs add to the historic warehouse feel. There's stuff everywhere: gifts, vintage cookware and clothing. The coffee is locally roasted Dunn Brothers, perfect with Jerabek's cookies, cakes, pies, tarts

and trifles. Some recipes are more than a century old (651/228-1245).

•MOOSELIPS JAVA JOINT

This northwestern Wisconsin shop is steeped in North Woods comfort. The former gas station in Seeley draws customers to its cozy wood-paneled interior for a morning cup of house-blend java and fresh-from-the-oven cookies, breads and other goodies (715/634-1006).

•SIMON'S CAFE & COFFEE SHOP

Early customers at Simon's start the day with fresh caramel rolls. A frothy cappuccino is a perfect accompaniment at the casual eatery in the Sioux Valley Wellness Center in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. The changing menu includes main dishes, salads, soups, fruit pies, desserts and coffees—all from scratch. It's all about flavor and presentation here (605/328-1624).
